GO-IEP and FTE: Using Reports in GO-IEP for FTE Reporting

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GO-IEP FTE Data Submission Report

- GO-IEP has a report that includes all special education elements collected in FTE except the 6 Program Segment Codes, Inclusion Codes, Transportation Segments, and Itinerant Teacher.
- GO-IEP System and School Admins can access it through reports by choosing Data for FTE Submission



Plan for Success

- Begin reviewing the FTE report early (August) and review on a regular schedule through FTE Count Day
- Other reports to watch:
 - Status Report
 - Meetings Report– Meetings Not Completed
 - Override Not Submitted
 - Services Report



Plan for Success

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- Have Case Managers check/ verify:
 - Eligibility categories match the most recent eligibility report
 - Publicly enrolled question is answered correctly

FTE Report

- Export to Excel starting in August
- Turn on Filters
- Sort/ Filter Column D: Service Minutes/ Wk
 - 1. Look for total number of minutes per week > 1800
 - 2. Look for "IEP NOT FINALIZED"
 - 3. Look for "Mock IEP"
 - 4. Look for "IEP Not Available"
 - 5. Look for "Not Publicly Enrolled"
 - 6. Look for Blanks



FTE Report

• Sort/ Filter Column Z and AW:

- 1. filter for Blank
- 2. The system admin will need to return to the student's profile page to enter and save the appropriate code.
- Sort/ Filter Column AN
 - Filter for "S" to verify list of Services Plans
- Sort/ Filter other columns to check information



FTE Reporting

- Infinite Campus(IC) has a tool that will import the report into IC
 - Generate FTE Record Extract gives users the report in a format that can be imported into the tool in IC
 - HELP includes the GO-IEP FTE File Layout if needed.
- PS is currently developing a tool to be able to import this report into PS
 - HELP includes the GO-IEP FTE File Layout if needed.



FTE Reporting

- Import regularly once FTE opens to capture updates when meetings are finalized.
- Compare to FTE reports in GaDOE portal.
- If importing, make a list of the GNETS students for the minutes/ per week to be updated in the SIS once no additional imports from the GO-IEP file will be done.
 - Currently GNETS services are still included, therefore any minutes per week currently provided by GNETS staff will need to be removed and manually adjusted in the SIS.
