



# **CRDC – Civil Rights Data Collection**

- December 13, 2021: The OCR Submission System for the 2020–21 CRDC will open on December 13, 2021, to all local educational agencies (LEA) and state educational agencies (SEA) assisting their LEAs with the 2020–21 school year data submission. All LEAs and SEAs assisting their LEAs will have the standard 75 calendar days and must submit their data by the February 28, 2022, close date.
- We will be ready to upload when it opens and will notify you when that upload has been successfully completed.







# SWD COMPENSATORY SERVICES

The two data elements added to the Student Record collection regarding Special Education compensatory services will not be collected this year. Those two elements are called **SWD COMPENSATORY SERVICES ELIGIBLE** and **SWD COMPENSATORY SERVICES COMPLETED**. They have been removed from the SR Student layout. We don't anticipate those elements coming back at least for this year.



### From a Special Education webinar on 8/19 \*

Reminder: SWD must have the ACS (formerly GAA) marked 'Y' in all years, not just the year the student takes a state assessment.

### **Guidance for Students Instructed in Alternate Content** Standards

- The GAA Decision Making Form in the IEP should be completed for any student who is receiving instruction using alternate content standards. Students will be assessed using the GAA at the appropriate grade levels.
- Students should be reported as YES for ALTERNATE CONTENT STANDARDS in FTE1 and FTE3.
- The designation of ALTERNATE CONTENT STANDARDS is used to be sure that teachers are appropriately certified to provide instruction in alternate content standards.

Improper reporting will result in errors in In-Field Status in Student Class.

### From a Special Education webinar on 8/19\*

Since all students in K instructed in Alternate Content Standards (formerly called the GAA students) must participate in GKIDS testing, should the IEP team complete the GAA decision making form in the IEP?

• Yes, The IEP team should complete the GAA decision making form. Completion enables the committee to determine and document that the instruction for this student will follow alternate content standards; and that the student is eligible to participate in GAA. The student, when appropriate based upon grade, will be assessed using the GAA rather than Milestones. Additionally, these students should be reported as YES for Alternate Content Standards (ACS) in FTE1 and FTE3. This information is used to ensure that teachers are appropriately certified to instruct students using ACS. Improper reporting may result in In-Field errors.

Remember that GKIDS does not require IEP documentation of accommodations.

# **Student Class**

#### **Question:**

How many different service areas can be served in one segment by multiple service area teachers?

- In other words, we know that general/regular education teachers can be paired with anyone of the other service area populations in one class period (i.e. Gifted, Special Education, EIP, and ESOL); but can any variation of Gifted, Special Education, EIP, or ESOL be taught by <u>MULTIPLE TEACHERS</u> in a single class period.
  - General .0 Teacher, REP .1 Teacher, and Gifted .2 Teacher all teaching in a single class period
  - General .0 Teacher, Special Education .9 Teacher and Gifted .2 Teacher all teaching in a single class period
  - REP .1 Teacher, Special Education .9 Teacher, and ESOL .0 w/E Teacher <u>all teaching</u> in a single period

#### Answer:

#### What you CANNOT have:

- A single student receiving multiple services in a class at the same time.
- A teacher providing multiple services in a class at the same time.

#### What you CAN have:

- A teacher can provide content and a service (like Reading and EIP, or Math and Gifted) but a single teacher cannot provide Special Education services to some students and EIP services to other students at the same time.
- A single class can have a content teacher who is teaching Reading and providing Gifted services to some students, while a second teacher is providing EIP services to some students in the class, and a third teacher is providing Special Education services to some students in the class.


